New church 'planted' in northwest

New churches form when a need arises or a group of people find they're missing something in their lives. They unite when a central character, usually a pastor, points the members in a successful direction.

The original Victory Church was, more or less, in Lethbridge, where a congregation, he said, has proven effective.

Under the guidance of Pastors George and Hazel Hill, a bank of telephones was set up at the church's Calgary offices. Then, using some 30 volunteers from Victory Christian churches in Alberta, 43,032 calls were made to homes in the northwest. To those, says Pastor George, they received 4,701 positive responses. Current churchgoers were not pursued unless they expressed interest.

Hill says, about 450 homes or 880 people said they would be interested in attending the first service. About 250, some of whom had never met but still had something in common, turned up at inaugural service just over a week ago at the Victory Community Centre N.W. for a had response according to the Hills.

The northwest church will be only the first in a series of new churches. Victory Fellowship churches will eventually be followed by facilities in the north, northeast and other areas. It hasn't been decided whether marketing will be used again to recruit members. The history of the Fellowship is one of rapid growth. Pastor Hill says it was never planned that way. The original church in Lethbridge started in 1974, in a local residence and congregation members were living as far away as Calgary, it was something had to be done.

That sparked churches in Brooks, Bow Island and Camrose in the next few years. Hill says the swift growth of the Fellowship churches may reveal more about the future of the church.

Congregation formed through telephoning

STATEMENT OF FAITH

we believe

- 1. In one true and living God**, eternally existing and revealed to us as the Father, Creator of all things; the Son, Jesus Christ, God Incarnate, and the Holy Spirit.

WHERE DOES IT COME FROM?

Every business class teaches the importance of vision – it is vital if an endeavor is ever going to get off the ground. We can study vision and seek to build a great one that people can get excited about. But as believers, sons and daughters of God, where should our vision come from?

Proverbs 29 tells us that where there is no God-given vision, the people live carelessly, they cast off restraint, they perish. This refers to not only our personal lives, but also the trajectory of society. Tozer put it this way:

“We need a baptism of clear seeing. We desperately need seers who can see through the mist – Christian leaders with Prophetic vision. Unless they come soon it will be too late for this generation” - A. W. Tozer.

Tozer’s generation has come and gone but the truth of his statement remains. Every generation needs men and women of God who hear His voice and lead from His commands. People of holy, Prophetic vision! People who live like king David, who “...served the purpose of God in his own generation...” Acts 13:36

Society has always struggled with navigating the unknown of tomorrow. Every generation faces new

David and his six hundred men followed after the enemy until they came to the brook Besor. Here, two hundred men stayed behind, too weary to go any further.

David and the remaining soldiers overtook the enemy and recovered all that was stolen. Returning home with the spoils, they reencountered the men who had remained to rest. The men who had defeated the enemy expressed that sharing with those who did not help in the recovery was unfair. Even so, David knew the importance of covenant connection.

1 Samuel 30:24 outlines the statute: "One for all and all for one." Everyone partakes in the Victory. Nobody is better than anyone else.

The heart of the covenant that binds us as Victory Churches is not self-seeking, nor does it profile ability, strength, preferences or style. It does not compare.

Victory Churches is built on unity in diversity. Each of us is different in our ways but linked in a covenant connection. We are in this to build the Kingdom of God together, and if one church has a Victory, we all have the Victory!

It is important to keep our hearts connected to our covenant to see our Victory movement stay strong and advance! ♦

These Scriptures teach us that there are five specific ministry gifts that God has given to the Ecclesia (Church) to enable God's people to do the work of the ministry. Effective fivefold ministry will equip the believer for the work of ministry and help to bring the whole body of Christ to growth and maturity, to look like Jesus Himself.

Jesus isn't coming back with a bride on a stretcher, but with a glorious Church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that it should be holy and without blemish (Ephesians 5:27).

Through servant leadership and Holy Spirit-directed gifting, their function results in the local church looking and acting like Jesus. Jesus is the fullness of the fivefold, who are not so much ministers but equippers of ministers. When the fivefold ministry is allowed to have its full expression and influence in the local church, then the fullness of Christ is seen and reflected in and through the glorious Church for which Jesus is returning. AMEN! ♦

What is a "Five-fold Ministry?"

The term "fivefold ministry" refers to specific roles or ministry gifts appointed by God in the church, based on Ephesians 4:11-13 and 1 Corinthians 12:28. The fivefold ministries are apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers. Victory Churches International is a fivefold ministry who reach, teach and mobilize the army of God!

A vision is a mental picture of what could be, fuelled by a passion for what must be. When leading with vision, one of the first things we must address is: "What problem are we called to solve?"

When we moved into Chilliwack and began looking for a place to live, the first thing we noticed was that there was a church practically on every corner.

We were even asked by a community member, "What are you doing here? The last thing this community needs is another church."

I responded with a question: "Do you go to church?"

His answer was, "No." I said, "That's why we are here."

I wish every church on every corner was full, but that's not the reality. There are many hurting people out there who need Jesus, but they view the Church as irrelevant, unwelcoming and judgmental. Many view it as a social club of people who think they are better than everyone else. We know this isn't true, so how do we become more intentional to make our church a place where people can encounter Jesus?

We need to build a culture and a community where people matter. For us, it started by leading with vision. We all know that vision leaks and culture drifts. So every time we gathered, we repeated our Victory Vision, and we celebrated our wins—because what is celebrated gets repeated.

Our focus became our REACH. We went to the men's recovery centre and local shelter. The more we went out, the more we grew. We started to see many people



coming to Jesus who needed discipleship. When others were closing their doors, we gathered even more (Hebrews 10:25). We started weekly leadership training nights, early morning men's prayer, and multiple connect groups. We knew that for us to experience different things, we needed to be willing to do different things.

As spoken by the prophet Isaiah: "For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness. I will create rivers in the dry wasteland." (Isaiah 43:19)

The next step was beginning to write and produce new worship music through which we witnessed the Holy Spirit move. These songs have now taken the Gospel around the world. We also launched our internship and started the first Christian radio station in the valley (collegestreetradio.com & 90.3 fm).

Since launching College Street Victory church in February 2020, we have seen over 1200 people born again and 300 baptized. Over half of those decisions have been from us reaching into the community and ministering the Gospel. We also saw twenty-one people give up their houses and homes and move from Alberta to BC to be a part of this Apostolic training centre—not to mention those who have sacrificed and have gone before us.

A special thanks to Pastors Morris and Lucinda Watson, the rest of the Victory Executive team, and our founders, Drs. George and Hazel Hill. Thank you for believing and investing in the Victory Vision. This vision makes all the difference.

We look forward to seeing JESUS glorified throughout our movement in 2024, the year of more! ♦

MOBILIZING FOR LOCAL OUTREACH & EVANGELISM

Most believers will likely admit their greatest fear is to share their faith, gladly choosing any other ministry in the church over evangelism! However, if we are going to obey the great commission of Mark 16:15, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature," then helping our congregation members overcome their fear has to be systematically and lovingly presented.

One approach to conquering this fear is to help believers learn to succinctly articulate their own salvation experience:

**"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb,
and by the word of their testimony..."**

REVELATION 12:11^A KJV

My training in this area materialized through an evangelist we brought in for Stampede Week years ago. We set up a mechanical bull outside our church and offered free rides — with one catch: you had to listen to a two-minute testimony from a volunteer. When I first heard the idea, I thought, 'There is no way I could share my testimony in two minutes!'

But after coaching from this evangelist, I edited it down to two minutes, and so did twenty-five other volunteers! Within a ten-day period, four hundred and fifty decisions for Christ were made. I was amazed!

After sharing that story recently in our church, many wanted to know how to develop their own two-minute testimonies.

For the most part, when I share my testimony with a lost person, it's longer than two minutes. But that training from the evangelist years ago greatly enhanced my confidence in sharing my testimony with the unchurched. ♦

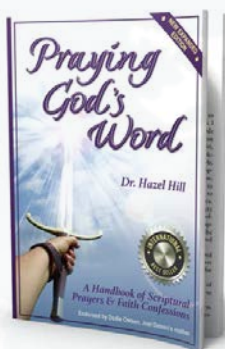

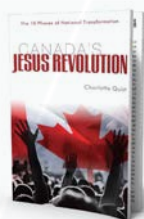
